**Pete Huttlinger**

Pete is the Year 2000 National Fingerpicking Champion. As a must-have sideman, Pete has occupied some pretty choice real estate: The Hollywood Bowl and London's Albert Hall with John Denver, Caesar's Palace in Las Vegas with George Burns and stadiums across America in Alan Jackson's "High Mileage" tour.



**Tim Grimm**

Tim is a musical story-teller, whether writing of his own journey back to the land, describing those who never left it, or honoring those who came before. Rich with descriptive details, these are songs sung with warmth and intimacy, recognizing the inextinguishable national romance with the idea of the family farm.

**Pat Kirtley**

Pat is a gifted performer who combines a rich musical heritage with a masterful contemporary technique. This National Fingerstyle Champion's musical roots are from the southern country and bluegrass tradition, but it is his original material that places him on the cutting edge of new acoustic music.

Guitarist Jim Hurst and bassist Missy Raines are two of today's most creative and compelling performers in acoustic music. Their unique sound is both sensitive and powerful. Together, they draw on their varied musical experiences to create a diverse blend of original, new acoustic, bluegrass, swing, and country blues. Missy Raines was voted "Bass Player of the Year" by the International Bluegrass Music Association for 1998, 1999, 2000 and 2001. Jim Hurst is the IBMA Guitar Player of the year for 2001 and 2002.

The Kelsey experience is as visual as it is aural. Those who see his live performance gain a whole new level of appreciation for this artist's amazing technique, his astounding finger work and his free flowing improvisation. Michael Kelsey has toured nationally as the opening act for Blind Melon and Dishwalla. He has opened shows for such notables as Adrian Legg, Tim Reynolds, Cowboy Junkies, The Bodeans, Carrie Newcomer and John Wesley Harding.



**Matt & Pauly Zarb**

Matt and Pauly Zarb grew up near Penrith NSW, Australia. In August 2001, they were invited as nominees to attend the 'Queensland Sunny Music Awards' in Brisbane where they were delighted to receive 'Best Folk Album' of the Year. In the "Song Writing category", their songs 'Vincent Rd' and 'For The Love Of A Child' were both placed in the top four.

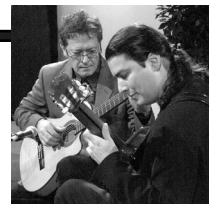

He has appeared with the Denver Symphony and Minnesota Orchestra and has been the subject of a musical documentary aired nationwide on PBS, called 'Simple Treasures.' **Edgar Cruz**, is a National Guitar Fingerpicking Champion and has been named the Oklahoma Gazette's Best Local Performing Artist and Best Acoustic Guitarist for three years in a row. He's been featured frequently on ABC, NBC, CBS and PBS-affiliate television and cable stations.
